We invented a way to make Tupperware® clear, fabrics that protect firefighters yet keep them cool, advanced moisture management for wound care. That same innovative, rigorous approach goes into our floor coverings. You get much more than just carpet.

At Milliken, cushion backing is standard. This isn't the case with most other modular carpet manufacturers. Cushion performance gives us industry-best moisture management, and increases durability by 40%-50%.

Color & Fiber

DDI, Solution Dyed Nylon, Continuous Dyeing — just three different rungs on the same ladder: Three ways to *chemically bond color and fiber*.

We make all three. But let's focus on DDI (*Digital Dye Infusion*) for a minute. It's a more accurate term than "print" because we don't "print" color onto fiber — DDI *bonds color directly into the fiber at the molecular level*. The result is exceptionally colorfast and durable.

Sustainability

Milliken has long pursued a multi-faceted, holistic approach to sustainability. We actively use renewable energy and maintain a zero waste-to-landfill policy throughout the US. We fully support the WELL Building Standard™ and its strong focus on the effects of built environments on the people inside.

All Milliken modular carpet products are NSF/ANSI 140 certified at either the Platinum or Gold level.

Most of our products receive "severe" TARR ratings, a result directly attributable to our cushion backing. Our carpet tile has a substantially longer usable lifespan than any hardback carpet product. It will need to be replaced or discarded less frequently. It's a basic piece of our holistic sustainability approach.

Site-Related Solutions

Moisture Management

How many moisture claims has Milliken had over the past 20 years? That's easy: ZERO.

A (Short) Science Lesson

Water vapor essentially just wants to evaporate. It rises naturally until something gets in its way. Hardback carpet is an impenetrable barrier, and won't let water vapor escape. Condensation will eventually create liquid water under the carpet, leading to mold, mildew, and adhesive failure.

Unlike with hardback products, water vapor travels freely through our cushion backing and evaporates naturally through the tile seams. What does that mean for you? **No moisture testing. No RH or pH limits. Fully warrantied.**

Non-Reactivity

Milliken requires little or no floor prep. Manufacturers of PVC hardback usually want old adhesives removed. Why? To eliminate the possibility of a nasty chemical reaction. Milliken cushion-backed carpet is chemically inert. **Chance of a reaction? Zero.**

Chemically abated floor? No problem. Use Milliken's Barrier Coating and take on zero risk. It's quick, easy and warrantied.



Time/Cost Benefits

- Superior moisture management allows installation to begin as soon as 30 days after new pours are complete
- No moisture testing is required, there are no pH or RH limits
- For renovations, virtually no floor prep is required
- Potential for catastrophic moisture-related failures is *essentially zero* — no interruptions to workflow, no expensive repairs

Health & Wellness

Air Quality

Dark, wet spaces lead to mold and mildew. Milliken moisture management virtually eliminates this possibility, alleviating air-quality concerns or the chance for mold issues to migrate to other building systems like HVAC. **No solvents and no grinding** negates air-quality concerns due to prep-related VoCs and airborne particulates.

Fatigue / Comfort

People feel better. An independent study by the University of Pittsburgh* shows cushion backing decreases muscle strain by 24% compared to hardback. This is crucial with the rise of sit/stand environments. People often notice a decrease in fatigue at the end of the day, and over the long term — which can lead to better moods and increased productivity.

Acoustics

Quieter spaces lead to better health. Workers in open-office environments showed heightened levels of stress, according to a Cornell University study. The likely result is decreased motivation and creativity. Milliken cushion-backed modular carpet absorbs 50% more noise than hard-backed tiles, which in turn absorb three times more noise than hard flooring.



Time/Cost Benefits

- Mold and mildew can create unhealthy environments, which in worst-case scenarios leads to illness and employee absences
- Floor prep can require the use of toxic solvents or grinding, affecting air-quality and increasing facility downtime
- Air-quality issues can migrate to other systems, such as HVAC
- Better comfort and acoustics increase productivity

Our warranties are extensive, and they are comprehensive.

Fourteen separate warranties apply to Milliken commercial modular products. There is (of course) a degree of overlap with what other manufacturers cover, for example:

- Face Fiber Wear
- Delamination of Backing
- Edge Ravel
- Dimensional Stability
- Tuft Bind/Zippering
- Antistatic
- Flammability

Like most manufacturers, Milliken warrants all of these conditions. But we want to draw your attention to some important areas where Milliken stands apart. Such as:

1 Color Pattern Permanency

Because DDI technology is often thought of as “print,” we sometimes hear longevity and walkoff concerns. Let’s address those concerns simply: Milliken is the only manufacturer who actually warrants that our carpet will exhibit no pattern loss during its entire lifetime. Because DDI is a chemical bonding process that bonds color directly to the fiber at the molecular level, it is exceptionally colorfast and durable. We stand behind all of our modular carpet (DDI, SDN, and Continuous Dyed) with a lifetime warranty for Color Pattern Permanency.

2 Moisture Vapor

This is a big one. Moisture in and around on-grade slabs can lead to costly failures and repairs. The use of lightweight concrete, and the constant desire to install flooring as quickly as possible (both on, and above grade) means moisture may very well be a serious issue. All Milliken cushion-backed modular carpet products boast a lifetime warranty against adhesive breakdown due to moisture vapor emissions. Ask other manufacturers if they offer a similar warranty. The chances are slim and none.

3 Cushion Resiliency

Milliken backing uses open-cell cushion. There is an array of benefits you’ll receive simply by choosing cushion backing over hardback. But what’s more, most manufacturers who offer cushion use closed-cell — and it tends to wear out over time. Milliken warrants that our cushion-backed modular carpet will retain 90% of its cushion resiliency during the lifetime of the carpet.

4 Floor Compatibility

Milliken cushion backing is chemically non-reactive. Many manufacturers require the removal of old adhesives. The reason: Plasticizer migration. Which means, in simple terms, that a chemical reaction can occur between the backing and the old adhesives on the floor. If that happens, your new carpet tile could start to slide around, as the adhesives dissolve into an oozing mess and stop holding them in place. Milliken guarantees no such reaction will ever occur — and we back it up with a lifetime warranty.

5 Staining & Soiling Resistance

Most manufacturers warrant Face Fiber Wear, typically defined as follows: Your carpet will lose no more than 10% of its face fiber by weight during its lifetime. Milliken warrants Face Fiber Wear. But we also warrant that carpet treated with StainSmart® will resist staining and soiling during the lifetime of the carpet. That’s definitely *not* something you’re likely to see from other manufacturers.

6 Floor Release

Milliken warrants that after initial installation, our modular carpet will release from the floor during its lifetime. If this doesn’t seem like a big deal, imagine the following scenario: Your carpet hits its end of life and you have to bring in expensive equipment (and take who-knows-how-much time) to literally *scrape the carpet tile off the floor.* It’s little things like this that make our product easier to work with — and make your life easier.
